1 ACADEMIC REPORT OF 2014:

The academic session of 2015 was good and result oriented as we desired. We had started the session of 2015 on 26th of April with the enrollment of 71 students in the beginning and concluded the session on 27th of October with the duration of six months and we did our best to give quality Education to our students during this session with the help of our sincere and hard working teachers. The school did not have any public holidays except the weekend and the seven days during the Shey-Festival as usual.

1. NAME OF THE TEACHERS

Pema Wangyal, Dorje Tsering, Dawa Wangmo, Norbu Choephel, and Kunsang Lhamo are hired by the project. Whereas Norbu Choephel teaches Tibetans, Pema Wangyal Teaches Mathematic, Dorje Tsering teaches Science, Dawa Wangmo teaches English and Kunsang Lhamo teaches health and Environmental education. Among these Teachers Dorje Tsering, Dawa Wangmo and Kunsang Lhamo are ex-students of Saldang School.

Beside these we have three teachers provided by the District Education Office (DEO) from Dunai. Mr. Gyanu Gurung is the Head Master and he was engaged with Government works regarding the school and Administrative works of school most of the time, Mr Manlal Budha is the Assistant Head master and he teaches Nepali. Mr Pratap Rokaya teaches Nepali Social Study. One E.C.D teacher Karma Chuney whose salary is provided by DEO, VDC and our project part by part. All together we have nine teachers in our school till this academic session.

3 STUDENTS ATTENDANCE DURING THE ACADEMIC SESSION:

This year we have seventy (71) students at the beginning. Among them only nine (9) students were admitted this year. Most of the students have given 100% attendance during this session. Few students couldn't give full attendance because of some household works as well as illness. There are sixteen (16) students in Nursery Class that is E.C D, where only two (2) were admitted this year. There are fourteen (14) students in class K.G where one student was admitted this year. Ten (10) students in class one, Six (6) students in class Two, six (6) students in class Three, six (6) students in class Four, seven (7) students in class Five and seven (7) students in class Six where three students were from Namdo and Karang school.

Among the seventy students of last year, we have eight drop outs where some of them have joined the monastery as monks and nuns, some joined TCV School in India.



DAILY ROUTINE OF THE SCHOOL:

8:30 am – 9:00 am (Morning Prayer)

9:00 am – 12:10 pm (Morning Classes)

12:10 pm – 1:10 pm (Lunch Break)

1:10 pm – 4:00 pm (Afternoon Classes)

4:00pm – 4:15 pm (Evening Prayer)

After 4:15 pm, we have some extra-curricular activities such as Dance class, Rhyming class and games. Miss Kunsang and Dawa Wangmo were engaged in teaching Tibetan and Nepali dance as well as songs to the students.

2. EXTRA CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES:

Regarding the extracurricular activities, we teach Tibetan dance, Nepali Dance, simple painting, and drawing. On Friday after lunch we have games and some physical exercises and give some knowledge about hygienic habits such as keeping the surrounding clean, washing of clothes, taking bath, eating habits etc which are very rare cases in place like upper Dolpa. These are part of our extracurricular activities that we have in the school. We also have audio visual cartoon, some documentary movies and Midas education program sharing with our students with the Laptops donated by Peter from U.S.A. We found that our students really enjoyed such activities.

3. EXAMINATION REPORT:

Every year we conduct two exams of full marks 40 for the first half and 60 full marks for the second half exam which becomes 100 full marks in total. We have taken the first half annual examination from 19th of July to 26th of July and most of the students have done very well. And second half annual examination was conducted on 18th of October and we have final result on 27th of October.

Along with this I have made the tabulation sheet of each of the classes and all the details of the examination.

4 THE WORK OF SCHOOL MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE:

This year all the school management committee members have changed and have not done any special contributing to the school but from the DEO they have promised a girls rest room for the school and they all have made proposal to the DEO of Dolpa. We have some Government officers from the DEO to check the activities of the school and they welcomed by the SMC and were very satisfied regarding our school.

On behalf of our SMC, I was very pleased to welcome Sir Michel, His Daughter Annick, His Brother and all the trekking friends of Sir Michel. We did had good time in School and it was really nice to have our schools' supporters in the school and to introduce them to our SMC and also to the Students and guardians.

VILLAGER'S CONDRIBUTION FOR THE SCHOOL:

As contribution from the villagers, 50 kg of firewood is always there. Apart from the fire wood they will access the school in the time of need.
