ACADEMIC REPORT OF THE YEAR 2023

INTRODUCTION: - This school is the second oldest school in upper Dolpa after Crystal Mountain school of Dho Trap vottage of Dolpo Buddha Rural Municipality located at Shey Phoksundo Rural Munnicpality Ward No:-3, Saldang village which was initiated by Karma Dhondup Lama Local of saldang village and Adelheid from Germany a member of Friends of Nepal in 1999 AD with a motive to give education facility to the children of upper Dolpa Where there were no schools at all during that time.



With their great thought and benevolent service this school has benefited more than hundred students so far with great out comes.

Still the Friends of Nepal is the main helping hands for this school along with other NGOS such as Altitude community support project Canada, Deutschehilfe e.v. Germany, Himalaya Current Inc U.S.A and Human-stiftung Germany supporting winter session of the school.



The school is operating very well with the great help and support from these supporting sponsors and also some support and teaching staffs from the Nepal Government.

ACADEMIC SESSION 2023:- we imitated the session formally from 30th of April 2023. On 27th and 28th of April we did the management part of the school with the help of some of the School management committee and private teachers since the government teachers were on the Way to saldang. We were somehow late in starting the new session of the year 2023 as compared to the date of former sessions due to unfriendly weather with snow fall which blocked the passes.

We started the new session with 65 students all together, among them 7 were new admitted this year. As compared to the last year we have less new admission this year. There were 14 students in the play group.



We have nine students in grade K.G and one of the boy joined Bijer School after a month. We have 8 students in grade one where one boy dropped out to join monastic education in Kathmandu. We have 9 students in grade two, 9 students in grade three, 8 students in grade four, 6 students in grade five and 5 students in grade six. This year all together we have five dropped out students and most of them are boys who are attending monastic education In Kathmandu and one girl who have taken admission at Tibetan school in kalimpong in India.



We have short Yertsa collection break from 3th of June 2023 till 18th of June 2023 which is very essential for the farmers to improve their financial problem where their children can also contribute. From 23rd of July we have conducted midterm examination as an evaluation which we have been doing every year and from 18th of October to 24th of October. We have ended the session 2023 formally on 26th of October with some cultural program and prize distribution of the result announcement of the examination.

In overall we have good, pleasant and result oriented session 2023. We did not have any problem throughout the session. All the students have done well enough as per their capacity and all the staffs and management members were very helpful and together in every step where necessary for the good of school and children. Among the five students of grade six, four of them are coming Kathmandu to join the hostel facility for their further study and one of the boy has decided to join monastery education.

From the above table, Gyana Gurung is the head master of the school from the government and he is responsible for all managing the whole functioning of the school. Sabina Naupane is a substitute of the sir Pratap and she taught Nepali social to the classes from 4 to 6 and mero Sherophero to classes K.G to 3. Manlal Budha is our Nepali teacher and he taught Nepali language and grammar part to the classes 2 to 6 and basic level Nepali language introductory part to classes K.G to 1. Chhaka Bahadur is our mathematics Teacher and he taught mathematics to all the classes



from K.G to 6. Nishana Dharala is the our play group level teacher and she basically takes care of all the small children and do the basic level introductory part of alphabet, numbers, Nepali scripts and basic writing for the children. Pema Wangyal is the project coordinator and is responsible for managing every need of the children and the school for the whole session that is provided on behalf of the sponsoring INGOS and sponsors and coordinating all the necessary reports and proposals to the sponsors. He also does the managing part of school's functioning when headmaster is away and teaches science subject to the students of grade K.G to 6. He also receives all the guests that comes to visit the school and do the coordination between the school management committee, headmaster and if needed even with the local government body as well. Dawa wangmo is English teacher and she taught English to grades K.G to 6. Nyima Dhargyal is Tibetan teacher and he taught Tibetan to grades K.G to 6 and he also taught extracurricular activities like dance, songs, sports etc. Kunsang Bhuti is

health and physical education teacher and taught the subject to classes from 1 to 6. Dinesh Dharala is the cook for the teaching staffs and he cooks for all the staffs and also the guests coming to the school. Late Urgen Khando was cook for the students and she used to cook lunch for the students and also makes the classrooms clean and tidy.

STUDENTS AND THEIR ATTENDANCE: - Throughout the session 2023, we have 65 regular students recorded in the daily routine record register and have come out with good result as well. There were few students from the play group and K.G grade who were not regular due to family problem mostly during yertsa collection season as they don't have elder grandparents to look after them in home. Other senior students were very regular to the school and were active with their learning as well.

EYE CAMP IN THE SCHOOL BY TREK AND TREAT:- This year we have eye camp in the school by trek and treat team, coordinated by Sakar Subedi. Shelri Drugdra also became part of this by providing space, furniture, food and lodging facility for the team. This camp has benefitted old aged people of saldang, karang, Lhuri and Nyisal villages. They have provided free checking, glasses for the needed ones and free eye surgery at Dho Tarap. Many have taken this opportunity. All our students have their eye checked.

They have given this facility to all the villages of upper Dolpa this year.



IMPROVEMENT WITH SCHOOL INFRASTRUCTURE:- last year our green house and upper part of the school compound wall was destroyed by the snow and this year we rebuilt green house for green vegetables. We have not improved the upper wall because there are lots of unfinished works left to be done with the eight room new blocks and on behalf of government they have completed one toilet.

YOGA CLASS IN THE SCHOOL:- Chhime Tsewang one of the former student of the Shelri Drugdra has introduced meaning and importance of practicing YOGA in our daily life for better and healthier life. He has learnt YOGA and now engaged very actively introducing and teaching YOGA to the youth of Upper Dolpa. He has done the teaching in every schools of upper Dolpa this year. If we could manage time we found it very useful and important.



MEETING WITH EDUCATION AND SPORTS DEVELOPEMNT COMMITTEE:-

The chairman of the education and sports development committee who is also the vice chairman of the Rural Municipality called all the headmaster, SMC chairman and coordinator to meeting on 29th of September and have discussion on various topics to bring changes in education and we have come to conclusion on the following topics.

- 1) Regarding the opening and closing date of the schools, we all agreed that all the schools in Shey Phoksundo Rural Municipality except Taprizi must be opened within 10th of Baisakh (10th of the first month of Nepali Calendar) and are not allowed to close before 15th Kartik (15th of 7th month of Nepali Calendar).
- 2) Regarding the curriculum, to bring oneness in the curriculum we all agreed to use Private Ekta production except Nepali language and Nepali Social studies we will use Nepal Government curriculum and for Tibetan or Bhot Bhasa we will use the curriculum developed by Nepal Buddhist Federation.
- 3) Regarding the selection of new teachers, from this year we have to announce vacancy and recruit new teacher in computation way.
- 4) Regarding the inter school competition program, we have concluded that this event will be organized by Education and sports development committee itself every year continuously.

VILAGERS CONTRIBUTION:- As part of villagers contribution, they have been supporting 30 Kg of cow dung as firewood for cooking proposes for the Teachers and 25 Kg for students mid day meal cooking proposes. Guardians of all the children are always there to support the school whenever we need their help and are very positive and thankful with the works and contribution of the donor sponsors for their children.

EXTRACULLICULAR ACTIVITIES: - As part of extracurricular activities, we have games such as football after lunch every Friday. Beside games we also have dance and singing classes taken by Nyima Dhargyal. We also have reciting of poems, storytelling and short speech on various topics every morning after the Morning Prayer. This year we didn't have the inter school competition due to some problem with the managing school. Next year this program will be managed by the education and sports development committee itself.

CONCLUSIONS:- In over all we have very good and successful session 2023 with good progress from the students. All the students have come out with good results. All the staffs have given their full effort to do best of their ability for the betterment of the school. The school management committee and the villagers have appreciated the team work and we all the staffs are satisfied and happy with the result we have this year.



At the end of the session we faced a very sad situation where we lost our very cheerful, loving and helpful caretaker of the children and the school who also cook for the children late urgen khando. She had served the since its establishment. We were all shocked and saddened by her sudden and untimely demise.
