DETAIL REPORTS OF THE SESSION 2025

INTRODUCTION: - Shree Shelri Drugdra Basic School is second school in upper Dolpa established by Karma Tundup lama local of Saldang village and Adelheid of Germany in the year 1995 AD. This school runs with the financial support from FREUNDE NEPALS e.V of Germany as main donor and also with the help of other donors HIMALAYA CURRENT U S A, DEUSCHETIBETHILFE e.V. GERMANY, HUMAN STIFTUNG GERMANY. Well-functioning of this school is based on the donations received from the above mentioned donors. With the donations from the above donors INGO, students are given free education with free each and every materials needed for the student. The school is functioning well with the generosity of the donors from Germany, USA.



SUMMER SESSION 2025:- As per the decisions made by the Sports and education committee of Shey Phoksundo



Rural Municipality in the year 2023, we started the summer session 2025 from 23rd of April 2025 A.D (10/01/2082 B.S). From 23rd April till 27th of April 2025, our local teacher along with some SMC members and grade 10 student as volunteer, carried out new admission and education Campion as guided by the Sports and education committee. From 5th of May 2025, we started our regular classes with 64 total number of student this year. There were six new student admitted this year and three of our students have left the school where one girl from grade four joined other school in Kalimpong of INDIA, one boy from grade one joined monastery education in Jhangchup Ghaphel link monastery at Nyisal and one girl from Grade K.G

joined Namdo school since she is living with her grandparents at Namdo village. From May 23rd 2025 till 7th of June 2025 we had Yertsa collection holiday. During this season, almost all the people they go to collect Yertsa which is their main source of income besides farming. This is break is decided by the education committee and they have issued notice stating that all the school should close at the same date and reopen at the same given date. So most of the children also go with their parent. From 10th of August 2025 till 17th of August 2025, we had conducted our first terminal examination. During this date, our people they went to Maryum la border for buying necessary food, clothing and other necessary materials for winter use and some of our local teacher also want to join the Tibet market and taking exam during this period will make easier for them too. From the 17th of October 2024 till 24th of October 2025 we had conducted final terminal examination and we ended the session on 25th of October 2024 which is final result announcement day and whole session closing day.



MORNING ASSEMBLY TIME:- We start our morning assembly at 8:30 am sharp with morning prayer and national anthem. Every morning we have morning exercise with the music in the free dance form which makes the children more active. After the morning exercise we have children activity of reciting poem in any language, sharing stories and fun jokes by their choice in any language. This is done turn by basis from class one to six. This activity helps the children to be confident and more expressive with teachers and other people. In the evening after 4:00 pm, we have evening prayers and after that we do some extracurricular activities learning dance, songs and games. These activities are taken care by our teachers Nyima Dhargyal, Dawa Wangmo and Tenzin Lhondup who are former student of this school.



SCHOOL STAFFS DURING THE SESSION 2025:- Every year we run the school together with the government staffs and project staffs. Sponsors are not providing basic needs of the student but they also supports teaching and non-teaching staffs to the school. Following list is the total number of staffs we have this year.

From the above table, Gyanu Gurung is the head master of the school from the government and he is responsible for management of whole function of the school and this year he also share Nepali Social study period and taught in grade six and five. This year the ward chairman denied to keep the replacement so Pratap stayed in the school by himself and taught Nepali social study to the grade three, four and mero Shero phero to the lower classes. Manlal Budha is our Nepali teacher and he taught Nepali language and grammar part to the classes 2 to 6 and basic level Nepali language introductory part to classes K.G to 1. Karna Bahadur Rokaya is new government teacher and he taught health and physical education to the grade three to six and games and basic health to grade k.g, one, two and three. . Nishana Dharala is

the our play group level teacher and she basically takes care of all the small children and do the basic level introductory part of alphabet, numbers, Nepali and basic writing for the children. Pema Wangyal is the project coordinator and is responsible for managing every need of the children and the school for the whole session that is provided on behalf of the sponsoring INGOS and sponsors and coordinating all the necessary reports and proposals to the sponsors. He also does the managing part of school's functioning when headmaster is away and teaches science subject to the students of grade K.G to 6. He is also responsible for receiving all the guests that comes to visit the school and do the coordination between the school management committee, headmaster and if needed even with the local government body as well. Dawa wangmo is English teacher and she taught English to grades K.G to 6. Nyima Dhargyal is mathematics teacher and he taught mathematics to grades K.G to 6 and he also taught extracurricular activities like dance, songs, sports etc. Tenzin Lhondup is Tibetan language teacher and taught the subject to classes from KG to 6. Bishal Budha is the cook for the teaching staffs and he cooks for all the staffs and also the guests coming to the school. Ngatup Dolma is cook for the students and she cooks lunch for the students and also makes the classrooms clean and tidy. Kunga Dawa is appointed care taker of the school and is responsible for taking care of the physical infrastructure of the school during rainy season and clear snow during the winter season. He also has to help the staffs and the school whenever there is program for managing all.



NUMBER OF STUDENT AND THEIR ATTENDENCE: - This year there were 64 regular students and some small irregular children as well. From the 64 total students, 10 student are from Nursery class where 4 student were admitted this year and five student are small children of last year who were not upgraded, 9 student in grade kinder Garden (KG)with one drop out. 6 student in grade one, 8 student in grade two where one boy left the school to join monastery education, 7 student in grade three, 10 student in grade four where two girls joined this year. 9 student in grade five and 6 student in grade six where one left to join further study in Kalimpong India. All the student were very regular, active and enthusiastic with their studies and other extracurricular activities during this session and we all the staffs and student enjoyed this session. EXAMINATION AND RESULT:-

Every year we conduct two examination as an evaluation of the student. The first examination is of 40 total marks and final examination is of 60 marks which in total make

100 in each subjects. From 9th of August 2025 till 17th of August 2025, we had conducted our first terminal examination. From the 19th of October 2025 till 26th of October 2025 we had conducted final terminal examination and we ended the session on 27th of October 2025 which is final result announcement day and whole session closing day. All the student have done well and have promoted to next grade for session 2025. Some very small children of ECD (Nursery) and very weak and irregular student are not promoted and will attend the same class in the session 2026. All four student in grade six will go to Kathmandu and join Shelter 108 hostel. They will continue their further study in Kathmandu. The hostel in charge has accepted to admit them all four girls this year.



SCHOOL MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE AND THEIR WORKS :-

School management committee being the head body of the school, they are responsible of taking the decisions regarding the improvement of the school and welfare of the student, staffs as well. They have still two more years and will be reelected elected or selected among the parents, social workers and respected people from the community after two years. So this year, there is no changes with school management committee and we hope they will benefit the school with their experience and dedication. This year they have taken active part in the school new admission Campion guided by Sports and education committee of Rural Municipality. They have taken active part in improving the playground which we had requested last year. We have been getting positive support from the management committee. INPROVEMENT WITH THE SCHOOL INFRASTRUCTURE:

This year we were able to improve the playground of the school the requested budget from the state government. All the responsibility was taken by the headmaster and the school management. They have also made a new three room block which I think can be used in future for library and computer room proper



managed office for the school. According to the headmaster, there is need of beds for the staffs and we have already managed all the needed beams and planks for that. Regarding the blocks there is no such emergency unexpected repairing needed. We have bought greenhouse plastic for the old blocks for the roof but have not done the roofing as there are some new issues to be clear. And I hope will be done in the year 2026.

EXTRA CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES: -

Beside regular Friday activities such as reciting poems in all three languages, hand writing competition and drawing painting competition among the student that we used to conduct, we have been guided to follow some important international occasions such as world environment day, hand washing day, children's day by the Sports and Education committee of the Rural Municipality. We did planting willow trees



inside the school compound, made ditch for dumping and experienced hand washing instructed by SUSWA staff with the children. Other outdoor games such as football, volley ball are always and small children also enjoyed indoor game like Ludo, carom board.

Singing, dancing, reciting poem, storytelling are part of our daily activities that is carried out in the morning assembly time and evening after prayer. These activities are being helped and taught by our project teacher.



VILLAGERS CONTRIBUTION:- The school is always being blessed by the villagers. They provide physical helps whenever the school needs and they also provide many necessary material and tools when we need them. They are very good source of green vegetables and dairy products such as milk, curd for the staff and student. They are always providing 30 kg of cow dung to the staff kitchen for cooking purposes and 20 kg of cow dung to the student kitchen for cooking lunch for the student.

CONCLUSION:- In over all we had pleasant session with colorful result from our students. All the staff and school management committee have put best effort as per their knowledge and ability. We cannot stop here without thanking and appreciating our selfless generous sponsors. Without your kindness, functioning of the school is impossible in the remote place like Dolpo. We would also like to thank Nepal Government, state government and local government for their moral, ethical and also financial support for the infrastructural development.
